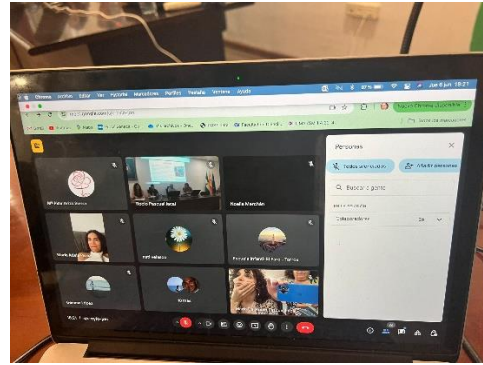




Successful Local Multiplier Event of the LIBERTEC Project in Malaga

On the 6th of June, the local multiplier event of the LIBERTEC Project, organised by the Pinolivo Infant School and the University of Malaga with the support of the Erasmus + programme of the European Union, took place with great success at the Faculty of Education Sciences. This event, which was held in the Sala de Grados, managed to bring together more than 70 participants, both in face-to-face and online mode, exceeding attendance expectations.



Programme Breakdown

The event was structured as a four-hour session, designed to address key aspects of the LIBERTEC project and encourage interaction between attendees. Below is a detailed summary of the activities that took place:

1. Welcoming of attendees (Time: 17.00 - 17.30)

The day started with the reception of the participants, who were warmly welcomed and registered for the activities of the event.

2. Presentation of the Project (Time: 17.30 - 18.00)

PhD. Rocío Pascual Lacal gave a detailed introduction of the LIBERTEC Project, highlighting its objectives, methodologies and future expectations.



3. Conference 'Revolutionising educational documentation through the appropriation of Artificial Intelligence. Strategies and tools for teachers' (Time: 18.00 - 18.45)



D. Guillermo Antón, a teacher specialising in IA, gave a lecture on how artificial intelligence can transform educational documentation, providing innovative strategies and tools for teachers.

4. Debate, discussion and participation (Time: 18.45 - 19.00)

A space was opened for attendees to debate and discuss the topics addressed at the conference, promoting an exchange of ideas and experiences.

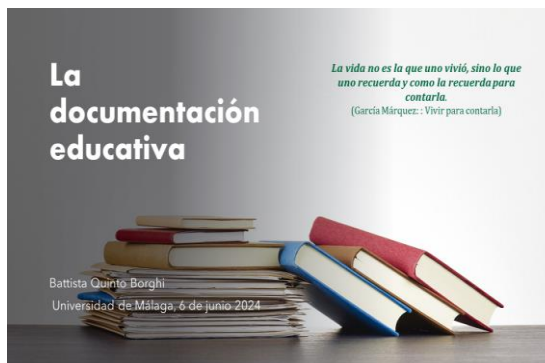
5. Presentation of the LIBERTEC Guide: Digitised pedagogical documentation. Techniques and tools (Time: 19.00 - 19.45)

Ms. Graciela Romero García and Mr. Alberto Cubero Serrano presented the LIBERTEC guide, which offers techniques and tools for the digitisation of pedagogical documentation, underlining its importance and practical applications.



6. Lecture 'Why documenting in early childhood school' (Time: 19.45 - 20.30)

PhD. Battista Quinto Borghi from the University of Bolzano, explored the relevance of documentation in Early Childhood Education, providing academic and practical perspectives on its implementation.



7. Debate, discussion and participation (Time: 20.30 - 20.45)

Another space dedicated to debate and the active participation of the attendees, facilitating a collective reflection on the topics discussed during the event.

8. Closing (Time: 20.45 - 21.00)

The event concluded with closing remarks, thanking all participants for their attendance and collaboration, and highlighting the achievements of the day.

Finally, it should be noted that it not only fulfilled its objectives, but also served as an important forum for discussion and learning for all those involved in early childhood education and educational technology.
